3. Paper Collection and Class Photo



If class suspension occurs due to typhoons, heavy rain, or other reasons, the paper collection arrangement for that day will be cancelled and there will be no makeup session. Otherwise, the report cards will not be distributed as scheduled on 10th July.

4. Post-exam Activities Arrangement

From 24th June to 10th July, there will be post-exam activities. Please refer to the attachment for more details. Students must attend school on time and cannot be absent without valid reasons, as it will be considered as truancy.
