Gathering Time and Location: 9:00 a.m. at the school playground


Return Time and Dismissal Location: Returning at 3:00 p.m., dismissing around 3:30 p.m. at Kin Sang

Please ensure that your child participates in this enjoyable activity with the teachers and classmates. Students who are unable to attend this trip must submit a written application in advance. Those who do not participate in the trip are required to wear their full school uniform and come back to school for revision from 8:00 a.m. to 3:50 p.m.. Break and lunch arrangements will be the same as regular school days. Students who do not attend the trip and are absent on that day will need to provide a doctor's certificate; otherwise, it will be counted as an unexcused absence. 4. Half-Day School Schedule

On 8th November, there will be a staff meeting, and students will follow a half-day schedule with dismissal at 1:30 p.m. Except for activities led by club advisors, which will be notified separately, all coach-led activities will continue as usual.
