Christmas Party and Singing Contest, Christmas Celebration and Prayer Service, School uniforms under the adverse weather conditions, 1st Term Exam, Christmas and Lunar New Year Holiday Supplementary Classes, Payment Notice

Please pay attention to the following items:

1. Christmas Party and Singing Contest

The Christmas Party and Singing Contest will be held on 19th December, Thursday, from 8:15 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. The details are as follows:

8:15 – 8:30	: Roll calls (classrooms)
8:30 – 11:00	: The finals of Singing Contest (school hall)
11:00 – 11:30	: Recess
11:30 – 13:30	: Christmas Party

There will be a Dress Casual Day run by our Student Union for raising funds to both The Community Chest and World Vision. Each class has to decide if they participate in the charity and each participating class has to donate \$300. Casual clothes should be neat and tidy and students need to follow the regulations set by our Student Union.

Class members who are not in Casual Wear Day should wear neat and tidy P.E. uniforms back to school.

2. Christmas Celebration and Prayer Service

The prayer service will be held on 18th December (Day 2) and the special timetable will be adopted. There will be 30 minutes for each session and the lunch time starts at 1:30 p.m. Students are required to return to classrooms at 2:35 p.m. and then enter the hall for the celebration and prayer service. Students will learn the meaning of the Christmas through the words in Bible and prayers.

3. School uniforms under the adverse weather conditions

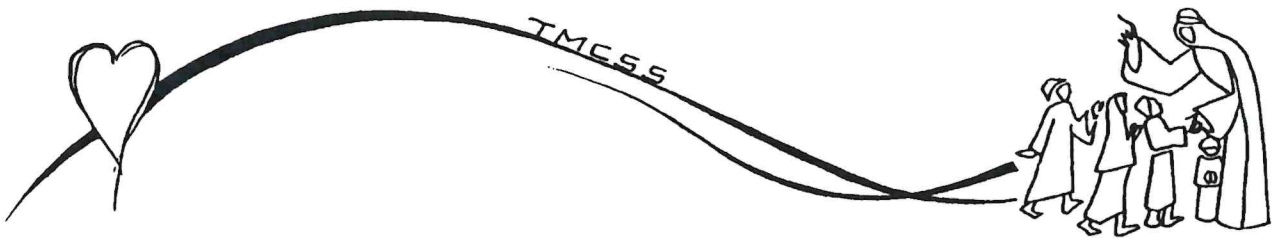
On days when the Observatory issues a Cold Weather Warning (with a temperature of 12 degrees Celsius or below in urban areas), female students may wear charcoal gray long pants or woolen long socks to school. On days when the Observatory issues a Severe Cold Weather Warning (with a temperature of 7 degrees Celsius or below in urban areas), students may wear thermal outer garments to school, with styles in solid colors of gray, blue, black, or white.

4. 1st Term Exam

The first term exam will take place from 15th January to 24th January. Please refer to the exam timetable as attached. Students are advised to better allocate the revision time and make good use of the coming holidays.

The second term will begin on 9th January (Day 1).





The exam marks will be a part of the annual score and the decision of whether the student can get promoted and the class allocation in F.4. Starting from this school year, junior form students will not be given the re-exam. If students do not meet the requirements, they have to repeat the same level for better consolidating their knowledge.

5 Christmas and Lunar New Year Holiday Supplementary Classes

The arrangement of the supplementary classes in Christmas and Lunar New Year holidays will be uploaded to eClass on 12th December. Students must attend all classes. If students need to apply for an official leave, please submit your relevant documents and parent's letter 3 working days before the supplementary classes. If students are sick, they need to submit the parent's letter and the medical proof on the first day upon returning to school. Students will be considered truancy if they are absent without reasons. If you have any questions, please contact the subject teachers.
