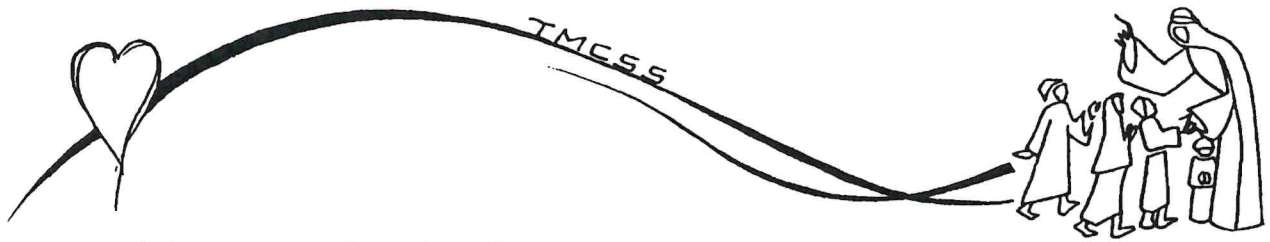
Date: 23rd February, 2025 (Sunday)

2. After school supplementary classes

The senior curriculum is intensive, and to provide students with additional time to reinforce their learning, supplementary classes will be held on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays after school (F.6 students will take the classes except Wed). Attendance is mandatory for all students. If a student cannot attend a class due to valid reasons, they must submit a proof document and a parental note to the class teacher three days in advance. If a student is absent due to illness on the day of the remedial class, they need to provide the parental note and a medical certificate to the class teacher on the next school day. An unexcused absence from the remedial class will be treated as truancy. The schedule can be found in the attachment, and students are encouraged to read it carefully.
