Participation in Lingnan University Experience Course and Visit, Annual Book Fair, P.E. lessons outside school campus and Payment Notice

1. Participation in Lingnan University Experience Course and Visit

Form 5 students will take a tour bus to Lingnan University on 20th February (Day 6) during class teacher period for a visit, a lecture, and course experience activities to increase their understanding of university programs. Students will gather in the Lower Hall after the seventh lesson for a roll call before departure. After the activities conclude, students will disperse directly at Lingnan University and there will be no bus arranged to return to school. Due to the rich program, the dismissal time will be extended to 4:30 p.m.

2. <u>Invitation to Book Fair and Authors Sharing Sessions</u>

Tuen Teen Book Fair is our traditional annual event, in which teachers recommend books and introduce different authors and genres. We aim to nurture students with good reading habits and widen their horizons. Our theme is 'Joyful reading with YOU'. Books including Chinese Language, English Language, Language Across Curriculum are available. The books cover topics such as Religious Studies, Literatures, Humanities, Natural Science and so on. Parents are also advised to read books about parent-child communication, information technology, cooking, planting and so on. 20% off is offered to Chinese books and 15% off is offered to English books. There are also books with special discounts. Parents are cordially invited to come on 15th March and read with your children. If you are not available to come, you are advised to support your children to buy books and nurture their reading habits.


