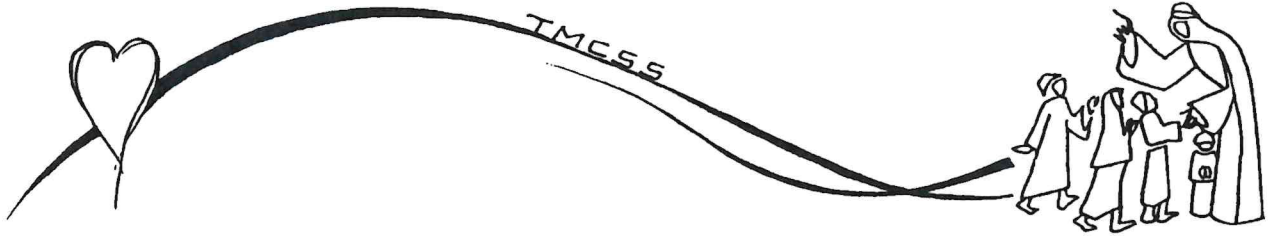
2. Second Formal Test (26th March to 31st March)

In order to assess students' learning progress, our school will conduct two formal tests and two examinations. The second formal test will take place from 26th March to 31st March. Please refer to the attachment for the test schedule. Students can return home to study each day after completing their tests, allowing them ample time to prepare.

We hope that parents will work together with teachers to help cultivate effective time management skills in students. It is important to create a study schedule for the formal tests and adhere to it, reinforcing what they have learned and striving for excellent results. I encourage both parents and teachers to join hands in motivating our students to work hard and prepare well for the upcoming tests.

The results of the formal test will be distributed on 7th May (Wednesday). These results will be included in the students' overall annual performance and will affect their promotion or retention, as well as their class placement in Secondary 5 next year. The school has established a re-examination arrangement for students in Secondary 4 and 5. Students who are on the borderline for retention can apply to take the re-examination in hopes of earning another opportunity for promotion, provided that they meet the required standards.





3. Summer Vacation Supplementary Classes

The school has arranged for senior form students to attend supplementary classes during the Easter holiday. Please refer to the attachment for details. Attendance is mandatory. Students who are unable to attend for any reason must submit proof and a parent's letter to their homeroom teacher three days in advance. If a student is absent due to illness on the day of the remedial class, they must submit a parent's letter and a doctor's certificate to the homeroom teacher on the next school day. Any unexcused absences will be treated as truancy. If you have any questions, please feel free to consult the subject teachers.
